The Waterville Swing Choir was selected out of all schools in the county. The performance will be approximately an hour after which dinner will be served. In May, the NYSSMA Solo Festival will take place in Mexico, NY. Mixed choir will participate in this event, which is similar to Junior High All County.

News from Mr. Moshetti: Mr. Moshetti reports that the Oneida Jazz Festival was a success. The festival, held on 3/10/17, provided the students with an opportunity to meet with world famous jazz personas. The festival involves a one on one clinic for the students and they receive feedback.
