The first was in the amount of \$2,920.00, representing the deposit. After deducting the cost of "Hello Dolly" and "THE RIDE" (\$6,720.00) to be paid by BOCES COSER, a balance of \$7,953.00 remains. "The Wiz"- flower sale, bake sale, admission table & production party- Karen Fox purchased Tootsie Pops and a discussion determine they would be sold in bunches of 5 for \$1.00. Karen also purchased tissue paper and chocolate roses. Colorful curling ribbon donated by Merri Rose Florist. Karen has ordered the carnations from Merri Rose. Karen will pick up the carnations and bring to the high school for the flower sale.

Bonnie will email Mrs. Worwa, Mrs. Hobaica and Mrs. Ryan to see if student council can support the flower sale as they have in previous years. Meredith Leland emailed Mary Blunt to see if the conference room could be used for storage. Debbie Salvaggio could use more volunteers for the bake sale. Bonnie will send an email to the booster distribution list to request more help. Amber Bell, Kim Richmond and Bonnie Padula will be at the admission table each night. Each day, Bonnie will pick up and drop off tickets, cash box and seating charts prior to showtime. Decorating for the production party will begin at 4pm in the cafeteria. Bonnie will check with Sandy to make sure the door to the cafeteria will be open at that time. Tammy Manderville will deliver the cake on Saturday night when she arrives for the show.

New Business:

Marching band trailer- Kelly Belouin will email Tracy Leone to request a meeting.

Marching band uniform fittings- Meredith Leland will send an email to Mr. Moshetti to see if the uniforms are back from dry cleaning. Once dry cleaning is complete, we can schedule fittings on Tuesday & Thursday from 6-8pm.

NYC Trip- A revised itinerary has been prepared. Departure will now be at 4:00am instead of 5:00 to ensure arrival in time for 10:00am tour known as "THE RIDE". After "Hello Dolly", dinner will be at Planet Hollywood instead of Hard Rock Café. Hard Rock Café could not accommodate our party of 80.

Bonnie was told by Cindy from Student Tours that we can fill the remaining 20 seats for those only traveling to and from NYC. We will offer to the faculty of WCS at a rate per person of \$65.00. This is an opportunity for the boosters to offset the increase in cost caused by admission to THE RIDE (Radio City Music Hall was booked). In addition, best trip pricing received when 100 travelers are booked.

The boosters were only able to sell 80 tickets to NYC.

Chicken BBQ- Amber Bell and Kelly Belouin will organize the Chicken BBQ to be held on 4/28 from 4-6pm. Tickets will be presold at a cost of \$10.00 per dinner. It was decided to sell 100 dinner tickets for which the cost is \$500.00. The chicken dinner will include baked beans, salt potatoes, dinner roll and a brownie. Music students will be asked to donate brownies. Amber will contact Bill Malpezzi to see if he is available. Bill prepares and grills the chicken at the Village of Oriskany Falls BBQs. John Misiaszek, from Maines Food, can order all necessary products for the BBQ.
