

Brothertown Music Boosters (June) Meeting: 5/29/19

Meeting called to order at 6:36pm by Kelly Belouin

May meeting minutes approved: first motion by Kim Richmond, second by Jamie-Lee Broedel.

Treasurer's report: Debbie reports a starting balance of \$17,000.87 in combined checking/moola account and a balance of \$3,727.40 in the savings account. A deposit of \$652.74 representing chaperone trip payments was made. Two outstanding checks are \$59.77 (purchase of Gatorade & granola bars from Walmart for parades) and \$459.86 (Jessica Lotyczewski to reimburse for flowers). This month, Deb will be preparing the following payments: \$741.00 (to the school for the marching band trailer), \$209.57 (Jamie-Lee Broedel to reimburse for pancake breakfast supplies) and to Willson's: \$1,114.50 (hanging basket sale and flower & plant sale).

Moola Money report: Kim Richmond reports a current moola balance of \$8,171.17. Students earned a total of \$134.32 in moola at the Chicken BBQ and a total of \$434.75 through the Hanging basket and Flower & Plant sale.

News from Mrs. Lotyczewski: Mrs. Lotyczewski reports that the Swing Choir will perform at the Masonic Lodge in Waterville on 6/11. The choir will be transported by bus from the high school at 4:15 and will return to the high school at approx.

9:30pm. Mrs. Lotyczewski also wanted to pass on that a student, Lauren Pederson, had an issue with the flower sale. At the pick-up, Lauren did not receive two flowers from her order. Kelly Belouin will contact Kristen Willson to see if the same kind that was ordered is available. Otherwise, the boosters will reimburse.

News from Mr. Moshetti: Mr. Moshetti would like to thank everyone for their support during the Memorial Day parades. We had a great turnout of chaperones. Next up: Sherburne Pageant of Bands. Rehearsal tomorrow for Jazz band will be from 6-7pm and marching band will be from 7-8pm. On Friday, the Jazz band and Saxophone ensemble will leave at 3pm for competition. They will return to WCS around 6:30pm. Concert band and concert percussion will leave at 8am for competition. Chaperones are asked to arrive by 7am to load the trailer. Marching band students participating in the blood drive this Friday are asked to be vigilant replenishing fluids in preparation for Saturday's parade. Mr. Moshetti has asked students to make brownies for the upcoming ice cream social. The Violet Festival in Dolgeville will be the following Saturday. Chaperones are asked to arrive at 7am to load up the trailer. The bus will leave between 7:45-8am. The parade will begin at 10am. Baggage check for the DC trip will be held on 7/2 at 6pm. Volunteers are needed. Any illegal activity by a student will result in immediate removal from the trip. This will be discussed with in detail at the upcoming mandatory parent meeting to be held during the last 15 minutes of marching band rehearsal next Thursday.
