

CONTINUING EDUCATION AND SUPPORT PLAN

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Covid 19 (Coronavirus)

It is the goal of the Waterville Central School District to continue to meet the needs of our community during this difficult time. We have put plans in place to provide for the nutritional, academic, and social-emotional needs of our families. Please read the details of the district's response below.

Nutrition

Meal pickups will be available from 11:00 to 1:00 daily. This will include one lunch and one breakfast for the following day. Sites for pickup include:

- Waterville Jr./Sr. High School Cafeteria (enter from parent drop off circle door)
- Deansboro Fire Dept.
- Oriskany Falls Fire Dept.
- North Brookfield Fire Dept.

Medication Pickup

Any student medications that are currently held in the school's health offices should be picked up on Wednesday, March 18 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

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- ❑ Personal belongings, Locker Cleanout, & Chromebook Pickup (7-12)
 - ❑ Memorial Park Elementary: Parents and students *may* come to the school to retrieve personal belongings on Wednesday, March 18 from 7:30 AM to 7:00 PM.
 - ❑ Jr./Sr. High: Parents and students must arrange to come to the Jr./Sr. High between 7:30 AM and 7:00 PM on March 18 to retrieve personal belongings, empty lockers (academic and physical education), and retrieve a Chromebook which will be used for online instruction. This will provide students the best opportunity to remain academically engaged as we move to online instruction.

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- Academic Expectations for Memorial Park Elementary
 - Students will receive a grade level packet that will be mailed home on Wednesday, March 18 (arrival by Monday, March 23).
 - Please contact the office if your student does not receive a packet.
 - Packets should be returned to school with students on Tuesday, April 14.
 - Teachers will check in on an every-other-day basis by phone to assist your students.

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- ❑ Academic Expectations for Waterville Jr./Sr. High
 - ❑ Instruction will move to online learning.
 - ❑ All 7th through 12th grade students will be granted access to a district email. Students can log in at Google.com. A student's email address is made up of the student's graduation year, first initial, last name plus @watervillecsd.org.

Example: John Smith, graduating in 2020 is 20jsmith@watervillecsd.org. The password is the student's network login password. Please contact the high school office if you have any difficulty.

- ❑ All students are expected to pickup a Chromebook on Wednesday, March 18 between the hours of 7:30 AM and 7:00 PM
- ❑ Teachers will check in with students via Google Classroom, Google Hangout, email, and/or phone as necessary.
