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Smart Bond Initiative

Passed by New York Voters in November of 2014
Awarded \$2 Billion to all public schools based on
enrollment and state aid formula

Waterville award is \$997,805

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Rules for these use of these funds

6 categories

- School Networking
- Classroom Technology
- Community Connection
- Pre-K Classroom Improvements
- Elimination of Temporary/Trailer Classrooms
- School Security and Safety

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Waterville Phase 1

In Fall of 2016 Waterville applied for and was approved for \$153,000 in Smart Schools materials. This included computer network upgrades, safety and security materials, and classroom devices.

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Step 1

- Administration consults with the district's architect to establish possible priorities in the approved categories.
- Consideration to
 - Waterville Strategic Plan
 - Waterville Technology Plan
 - Building Condition Survey
 - Existing or Pending Capital Projects

- 1) Pre-K Bathroom Construction
 - Age appropriate restroom facilities for Pre-K classrooms

- 1) Additional Security equipment including:

 - Door monitoring sensors
 - Emergency communication

2) Upgrade Network Infrastructure including the core switch, edge switches, and wireless access points.

- Board of Education possibly approves final plan for submission to NYSED.
